- swelling and extreme pain from puncture wounds
- wounded area is cold
- wounds near nerve-rich areas or with bruising
- better from cold and cold applications

- puncture wounds
 - may protect against tetanus
- bites insect-animal
- insect stings
- sprains of lower limbs
- may protect against Lyme's
- black eye
- · contusions of eyes and eyelids
